Donald J. Bielski '77

Don received his undergraduate degree in 1981, and then attended the University of Wisconsin Law School, graduating cum Laude in 1984. He was a staff attorney for the Kenosha Public Defender's Office from 1984 to 1997. In 1997, he opened his own practice in Kenosha, where he remains to this day. In addition to criminal and misdemeanor cases, Don is also involved in child welfare cases where he is also an instructor for the State Bar. In 2008-2009, he served as president of our local bar association. In the community, he has served on the board of Women's Horizons and also served on the board of the Hope Council, a alcohol and drug treatment referral service. Don has served on the Lambda Chapter Building Corporation board since 2008, serving as secretary since 2009 until the present day, and occasionally providing legal advice.

David Nelson '77

David received his BA from the University of Wisconsin in 1978, majoring in economics and international relations. While a Senior, he passed the Foreign Service exam, and joined the US Department of State in 1979. As a Diplomat, David represented the United States in 7 overseas assignments, including as US Ambassador to Uruguay. He also served in several senior positions domestically, including at the National Security Council and in leadership functions in the Economic and Business Bureau of the Department of State. After retiring from the Foreign Service in 2011, David continued to work in the public policy arena. In 2018, he founded a consulting firm — Global Business Policy-DC, helping US firms such as Cargill succeed in the global economy.

Paul started working for Miller Brewing Co in 1980 in college marketing. A highly successful career with many promotions eventually brought him to his last position, Vice President of Sales. He retired in 2018, and in August 2020 launched Iron Joc Performance Gear. https://ironjoc.com/ which competes with other brands such as Under Armor, Nike, and Adidas. Iron Joc has a proprietary fabric that provides wicking, cooling, 4 way stretch, anti-static, water repellency, and stain blocking. As a result, when you sweat the silver ions kill 99.9 of the bacteria. His awards include being named employee of the year for Sales and Marketing in 1992, 1999, and 2010, and Leader for Women's Development and Mentoring at Miller Coors.

Kameron (Glenn) Weeden attended the University of Wisconsin Madison in 1987 and completed his four year bachelors degree by winter break 1992. Kam rushed TKE the fall semester 1987 but did not initiate as the chapter left campus for a couple years. During Kam's junior year, he and some friends, among others, formed a colony and started Teke back on the UW Campus. Kam became one of the new chartering members in 1989. The following year TKE took back the house, which had been leased to the ZBT local chapter during Teke's absence. While a member, Kam served as Chapter Histor and Judicial Board Chairman.

After graduating, Kam served a year as the Resident Advisor for the Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity on N. Lake Street before becoming the Chapter Advisor for TKE. Kam served as chapter advisor for several years before joining the Lambda Chapter Building Corporation as an At Large member. Kam has served with the board for many on-and-off years. Kam currently co-chairs the Facility Management of the Chapter House with Frater Jon Jensen. Kam retired as a deputy sheriff from the Dane County Sheriffs Office after 28 years of service and currently lives in San Antonio, TX. Kam received the honor of being inducted into the TKE Hall of Fame, via zoom, during the 2020 Covid ceremony.
